

Internship Wage Data Fact Sheet

- ✓ The output values provided by this program show the median wage as well as the wage band for each occupation. The wage band is the high and low wage paid for a selected occupation in a given region. For example, if you select *Accountant* in Salt Lake City, the program might provide a median wage of \$15.50, with a wage band of \$14.00 to \$18.00. Outlier values (statistical anomalies) are not included in the wage band.
- ✓ Data for this program are based on actual values derived from establishment reported data, with over 500 workers. No employee reported data are used.
- ✓ Occupation list – consists of 180 occupations using the O*NET occupational classification system.
- ✓ Internship levels – 4 education levels and the corresponding wage levels are provided.
- ✓ List of regions – consists of 250 metropolitan statistical areas (MSA).
- ✓ The available data are insufficient to support a larger list of occupations and regions than are provided by the program. If you require data for an occupation which is unavailable from our program, you may consider using the most similar occupation which is in the program. If you require data for a region which is unavailable from our program, you may consider using a similarly situated region and then applying a weighting factor for any final adjustment that may be necessary.
